We, the undersigned voters of Kansas City, Missouri, wish to register our support for the following ordinance:

Production of nuclear weapons components prohibited

A mandate for employment of a minimum of 2,000 people has been provided by the city of Kansas City in selling municipal bonds for up to \$815 million to finance the new Kansas City Plant at 14500 Botts Road. The city's Planned Industrial Expansion Authority (PIEA), with members all appointed by the mayor of Kansas City, holds the legal title to the facility. Accordingly, the voters determine:

- 1) Production of new environmentally sound energy or other environmental technologies which will benefit the residents of the municipality and surrounding areas is recommended as the preferred use of this facility, and
- 2) Production of any component for nuclear weapons is strictly prohibited at the new facility at 14500 Botts Road, in order to prevent the contamination of grounds, employees, and regional watershed, as documented extensively at the current plant at Bannister Federal Complex (Bannister & Troost).

Instructions on gathering petitions for volunteer identification

Unlike the petition to put this on the ballot, which had strict legal requirements, this is for our information, as well as a count that may help us in fundraising from grant makers.

Using an unsigned petition, you may photocopy as many of the petitions as you think you might need. You can download and print copies of the petition, and the accompanying brochure, from www.peaceworkskc.org/kcplant.html.

We have one petition for voters in Kansas City, and a different one for those who don't vote in Kansas City (live outside, too young, live inside but vote elsewhere, felons). If someone signs the wrong one, don't worry; we'll deal with it in the processing. It's just better to have it right because we ask different things of different people. We obviously don't need the phone number for a reminder to vote right before the election to people who don't vote in it, and our meager resources in yard signs need to be concentrated in the city where the vote is. But we'll need all the help we can get from others as well.

If people aren't volunteering, you can assure them that the phone number will be one call only: a reminder right before the election to go vote. If they are volunteering or want a speaker, then of course we'll need either the phone number or the e-mail address.

If you or they feel a need to add a short note for more information, this is fine; if a long note, it can go on a separate sheet since it can be matched up with the person's name. If they want more than one yard sign or bumper sticker, then the number wanted can be used instead of a check mark or added on the side.

And of course people who already signed to get this petition on the ballot are strongly encouraged to sign this again – this is for a different purpose. We keep it, and it won't be turned in to the City Clerk.

Don't worry about duplication. If they've already signed it before, we'll catch it and adjust the count. Better for them to sign it twice or thrice than not at all.
